The day is free to rest or start exploring the lively British capital. This afternoon join Bob for a walk around our neighborhood to see where we are, where the restaurants are, banks, grocery stores, pubs, etc.

Evening: Three course dinner in the Covent Garden area -

perfect for shopping, exploring, and people watching.

Saturday, July 22, 2017 - Touring London

Breakfast at the hotel is included

Morning sightseeing with a professional London guide for a panoramic tour of London. Highlight is a visit to the Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace, if held.

Afternoon free for your personal exploring. Everyone will have a 20 pound "London Oyster Card" including activation fee for using the "tube".

Evening Meet tour leaders in the lobby of our hotel to take the tube to our first play (to be determined).

Sunday, July 23, 2017 - Tour to Windsor Castle

Breakfast is included at the hotel

Morning

Take a guided bus tour to Windsor Castle & Hampton Court. Windsor, the Queen's weekend residence, has been a royal castle since the predecessor of the Round Tower was built by William the Conqueror in the 11th century. Within the precincts, Kings and Queens throughout the centuries have made their own contributions; among them the Horseshoe Cloister, Henry VIII's Gateway and St. George's - the chapel of Knights of the Garter.

Optional this afternoon - Join Bob to take the underground to St. Paul's Cathedral, scene of the wedding of the Prince and Princess of Wales (Charles and Diana). This beautiful building, the masterpiece of Sir Christopher Wren, is one of London's most famous landmarks.

Evening Meet tour leaders to take the tube to our theater for our second performance.

Monday, July 24, 2017 - Full day tour to Stratford-Upon Avon

Breakfast is included at the hotel

A full day's sightseeing trip to William Shakespeare's home town, Stratford-Upon Avon, with its half timbered Elizabethan architecture and rich tradition as a place of literary pilgrimage. See Shakespeare's birthplace, set in flower-filled gardens, Anne Hathaway's Cottage -- a picturesque farmhouse in the nearby village of Shottery. This afternoon we drive back to London for overnight.

Tuesday, July 25, 2017 - Full day included tour to Bath and Stonehenge

Breakfast is included at the hotel

Superb Georgian architecture is revealed on a visit to the spa-town of Bath where sightseeing includes a tour of the Roman Baths and the Abbey. Lunch is on our own. Later you cross Salisbury Plain to see the mysterious ancient monoliths of Stonehenge before returning to London past Runnymede, where King John sealed the Magna Carta in 1215.

Evening free - join tour leaders for a meal at a local pub (at your own expense)

Wednesday, July 26, 2017 - London - Optional British Museum Visit
Breakfast is included at the hotel

A free day to finish up your shopping or sightseeing

Morning For those who want to, join Bob to visit the British Museum. (Free entrance - only pay tube cost)

Afternoon - take the tube to visit to the Tower of London (entrance fee included)

Evening included theater performance

Thursday, July 27, 2017- Return home or optional - Eurostar to Paris, France

Breakfast is included at the hotel

For those returning back to the USA - you will be transferred to the airport for your return flights home.
