In Port Stanley, the islands play host to more penguins than people, and travelers can enjoy the antics of approximately half a million of them during nesting season.

Spend two relaxing days on your boutique hotel at sea before it's on to the artsy seaside resort of Punta Del Este, Uruguay, and its white sand beaches, fashionable cafés, and shop-lined streets.
