We then spend two days at sea, so you can put your newfound tango skills to the test at the Cabaret Lounge or the Living Room. Get set to samba along the Brazilian coast for the next few days. São Paulo is dynamic, diverse, and definitely worth exploring—if only for its rich food culture. In contrast to Brazil's largest city, the colonial gold rush town of Paraty seems frozen in time, while picturesque Buzios boasts 20 beaches and chic shopping.

The real highlight of this voyage is three days in Rio de Janeiro. Take in sweeping views of the city and soaring mountains beyond when you trek up to the towering Christ the Redeemer statue, and live it up with the locals at the world's most famous stretch of sand—Copacabana Beach. We've got two more days at sea next, so you can rest your dancing feet poolside, or at Sanctum Spa. In Punta del Este, art and nature pair in perfect harmony. Spend time sunbathing, touring the sculpture gardens, and reflecting on your immersive journey before we return to Buenos Aires for your departure home.
